Thank you for submitting an application with Animal Rescue New Orleans (ARNO) and choosing to adopt or foster! Your support helps us get closer to our mission of "One by one until there are none!"

Now that you've submitted an application, here are the next steps:

Your application goes to our adoption team - one of our adoption team volunteers will contact you within 24-48 hours (or the next available business day if your application is placed on a weekend or holiday). Your processor will guide you through the next steps that usually look like this:

- review of application
- a vet and landlord check (if applicable if you have not owned a pet within the past 10 years or a first time owner, we will need an employer character reference)
- a home visit (we check fences, plants, etc. it will typically only take about 10 minutes!)
- a meet and greet with your other pets this is usually done at ARNO during the adoption appointment (if applicable and exceptions can be made on a case by case basis)
- adoption appointment

Fees:

Dogs: The adoption fee includes spay/neuter, up-to-date vaccines, deworming, a microchip, heartworm test, and heartworm treatment if required. Puppies under 1 year - \$300-\$350, Adult dogs (1 year - 7 years) - \$250, Seniors (8 years and older) - \$200.

Cats: The adoption fee is \$85 for 1 adult cat, \$125 for 2, \$125 for 1 kitten or \$150 for 2 kittens. This includes spay/neuter, up-to-date vaccines, deworming, a combo FIV/FeLV test, and a microchip.
