THE NEED

It has been a long-awaited goal for Animal Rescue New Orleans (ARNO) to have a building we can call home. This new building requires repairs and renovations to transition it from an office building to an animal shelter. This must be complete before we can move our animals into the new building.

The Almost Home Capital Campaign fulfills the dream of having a permanent home. Purchasing the building was a huge step, but we have a ways to go. With your help, we've done an incredible job of keeping our animals comfortable and safe in a building that is lacking.

The new building will provide an efficient, climate-controlled environment that will keep our dogs and cats more comfortable until they find forever homes. It will be cost efficient (Renting v. owning), have more green space, and an improved environment for our companion animals' mental health. It will provide expanded capacity during extreme weather and emergency situations (Proved to be an excellent safe-haven and sound structure for sheltering in place during Hurricane Ida).

Our new facility will be a friendly space where people and animals can interact. Like spokes on a wheel, there are many components to creating a community where all animals are cared for and loved. We pledge to be resourceful, and we thank you in advance for joining the ARNO Krewe to embark on this incredible journey of unleashing hope – hope for a better shelter and hope for the animals by giving them a second chance at life.



Why we exist: A no-kill shelter animals while AR promoting foster, adoption, and spay/neuter of all



After Katrina, levee breaches resulted in over 250,000 pets stranded when their owners were forced to flee their homes. Existing animal welfare groups saved more than 15,500 of them, but a month after the storm, ongoing need led to the founding of Animal Rescue New Orleans (ARNO).

Formed by Charlotte Bass Lilly (1950-2015) and local volunteers, animal first responders, feeders, and trappers in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina.

For over 16 years, volunteers and a small staff have kept that mission alive while serving the community as a resource and advocate.

Throughout its entire history, ARNO has worked side by side with shelters to reduce the euthanasia rate of companion animals and create a society in which all companion animals are more valued.

NO-KILL private, nonprofit 501(c)(3).

Operating 365 days/year.


Small staff, relying on volunteers and community support.

CURRENT SHELTER & THE VISION

Operating out of converted warehouse.

Current shelter: Poorly insulated, lacking central heat and air, makes keeping our animals comfortable during the hot summers a pressing challenge. Limited parking, office, and medical space. No rooms for meetings, adoption meet and greets, training or education.

New shelter: insulated, climate-controlled. Will provide a bigger outdoor area for play groups, behavior training, and for the dogs to spend more time outside of kennels. Ample parking and space for all rescue needs.

For our cats, we will have a larger space indoors and take care of our feral cat colony outdoors.

Your contribution today will take us to the next level as we continue to serve the community and animals of the Greater New Orleans area and beyond.


